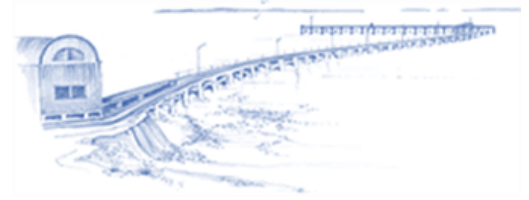

### PORT VICTORIA MUSEUM: PROUDLY INDEPENDENT

Open 2pm to 4pm Saturdays



Congratulations to the hardworking enthusiastic group who made the 150-year event such a success. So many past residents came back with their great memories of the town.

The museum was packed each day and so many stories shared – such as the name of the diver whose suit is displayed. He was a Norwegian whose daughter lives at Port Vincent.

The granddaughters of Lewis McArthur, the harbour master who rescued the crew on Jean Bart as she was breaking up, showed us his bravery medal. They saw the letter their grandmother wrote when the rock was given to the museum.

The son of Alf Nagel, a Cape Horner in 1936, gave us his father's diary and pictures. Another lady saw a photo of her dad on Passat in the collection from Maurice Corigliano that she had never seen before.

The free entry resulted in many donation and we are very appreciative of the generous donation form the estate of Roma Schulz, a very special lady.

The rewiring and installation of an air conditioner has made the building safe and comfortable, the white ants have gone, and the veranda has been repaired. The recruitment of extra volunteers is showing promise.



## Port Victoria ANZAC Day Dawn Service

The Gallipoli Campaign was one of the Allies great disasters in World War One. It was carried out between 25th April 1915 and 9th January 1916 on the Gallipoli Peninsula in the Ottoman Empire. The doomed campaign was thought up by Winston Churchill to end the war early by creating a new war front that the Ottomans could not cope with. Even though the Gallipoli campaign failed in its military objectives, the Australian and New Zealand events during the campaign left a significant legacy. The "ANZAC legend". became an important part of the identity of both nations. When WWI was declared 37 men from Wauraltee Ward, Port Victoria, enlisted for service. At war's end 13 of the 37 paid the supreme sacrifice. In 1925 as a memorial to these men, a Soldier's Memorial Hall was built adjacent to the institute in the main street of Port Victoria. Following the outbreak of WWII, 75 residents of Port Victoria enlisted during which 6 men made the supreme sacrifice. Between 1962-1972, four residents of the district served during the Vietnam War.

We will honour the memory of these men and others who have fallen in battle but we will also share the sorrow of those who have mourned them and of all who have been the victims of armed conflict.

The Dawn Service: With symbolic links to the dawn landing at Gallipoli, dawn ceremonies became a common form of ANZAC Day remembrance. Originally the Dawn Service was for old soldiers to remember and reflect among their comrades with whom they shared a special bond. In more recent times families and young people have been encouraged to take part in Dawn Services allowing them to appreciate the sacrifices of their forebears.
